



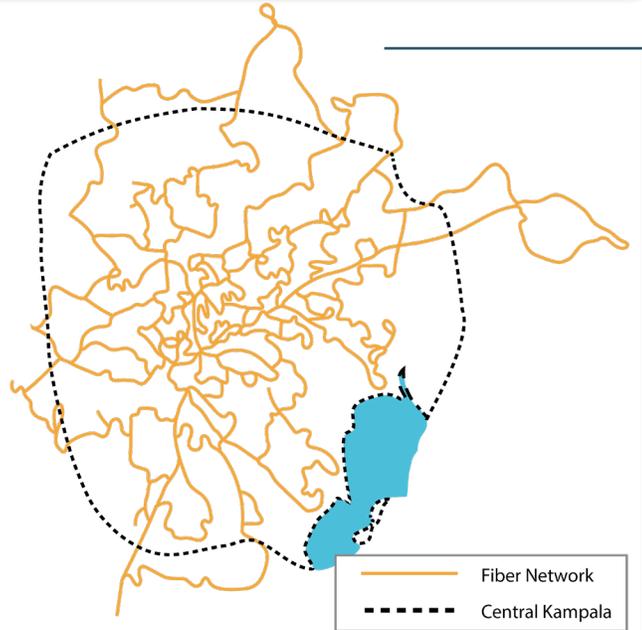

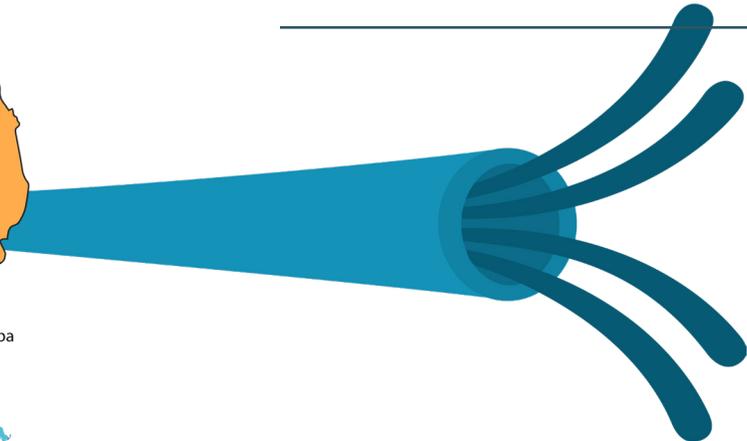
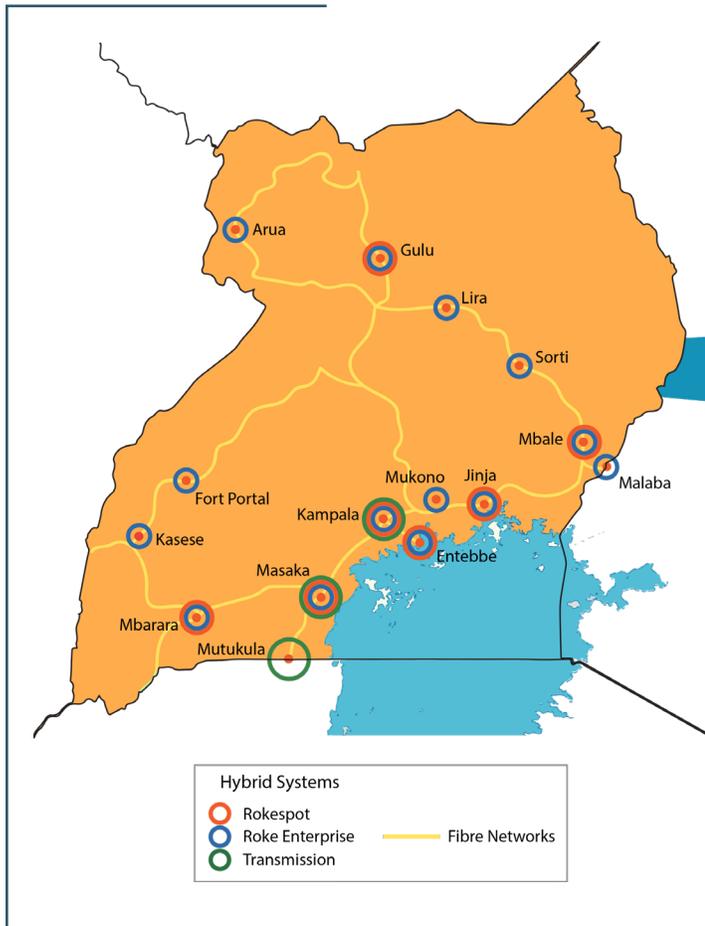


Our Bandwidth Aggregation Program (BAP) enables NGOs to save on Internet costs by collaborating with neighboring organizations.

Through the BAP, we negotiate the Internet bandwidth of 2+ organizations in a specific region to **reduce the cost of Internet services by 30-55%** for each organization.



The fibre optic network infrastructure that has been installed in Kampala plays an integral part in our BAP network.



In Uganda, our BAP relies on a partnership with **Roke Telkom**, an Internet service provider with an extensive fibre and wireless network throughout the country and the surrounding areas. Roke Telkom uses an access network that is a hybrid of technologies based on the client's physical location, providing **Google Fibre** using GPON Technology, Gigabit Ethernet, and/or Fixed Wireless. The resilient fibre network consists of a terrestrial and submarine infrastructure, ensuring wide and stable coverage.

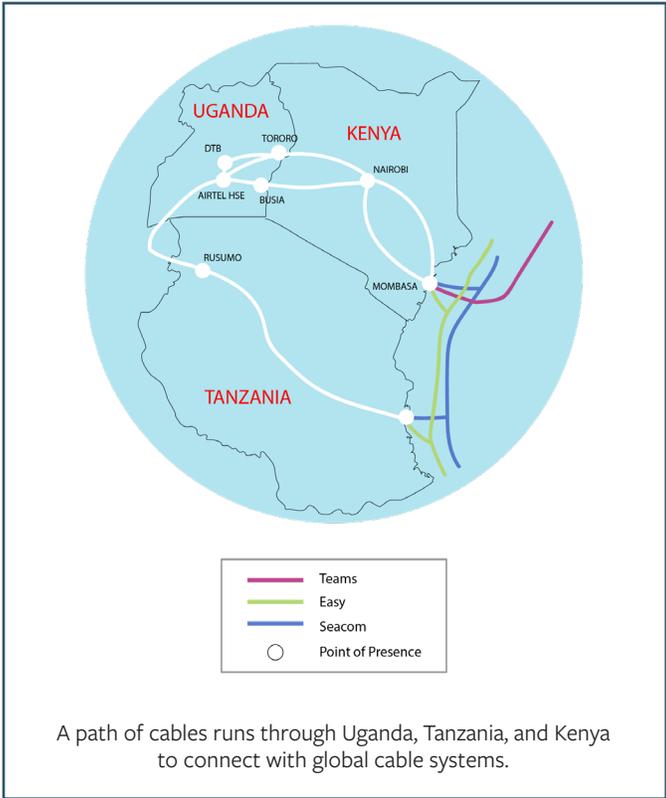
